This systems model demonstrates the fluid nature of the NPD practitioner's scope of practice, which has been approved by the American Nurses Association (ANA).

The inputs consist of the learner and the NPD practitioner. NPD practitioners engage in environmental scanning to identify practice gaps. Their practice is built around the NPD standards of practice, which have been acknowledged by ANA. NPD practitioners operate in the seven roles represented by the numbered cogs and listed in the lower left corner. Their practice occurs in the interprofessional practice and learning environment as noted in the lower right corner.

When a practice gap is identified, the NPD practitioner engages with learners and enters the throughputs represented by the large central gear. The "Big 6" throughputs represent the NPD practitioner's responsibilities. These responsibilities align with their organization's mission and vision, which is central to NPD practice.

The outputs of NPD practice consist of learning, change, and role competence and growth. These outputs ultimately lead to optimal care for patients, who are represented at the top of the model, signifying their importance to every facet of NPD practice. This optimal care contributes to population health. Outcomes in turn serve as feedback to guide future NPD initiatives.

The motion in the model represents the fluid nature of NPD practice in today's complex healthcare environment.

The Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) Academy is a 12-month mentored program designed to guide the NPD practitioner through conducting an EBP change initiative at their

organization or in their practice setting. Curriculum components include creating a PICOT question, gathering and critically appraising the literature, conducting an EBP initiative, implanting an intervention, evaluating the impact, dissemination, and sustainment. The Academy consists of synchronous seminars and asynchronous modules for participants. In addition, participants are matched with a mentor who will be their guide and support them throughout the duration of the academy. Participants submit their work for inclusion in the poster presentation and are given the opportunity to be selected to present a podium presentation at the ANPD Aspire Convention.

The purpose of the NPD EBP Academy is to enhance the EBP competencies of NPD practitioners to enable them to fulfill their role as champions of scientific inquiry. In addition, completion of the EBP Academy will result in building the skills to mentor other healthcare professionals in the implementation of EBP practices.
